PEDIATRIC NURSE PRACTITIONER (PNP) - ACUTE CARE / PRIMARY CARE

With 89 total credit hours, the Pediatric Nurse Practitioner - Acute Care / Primary Care concentration includes the entirety of the PNP - Primary Care curriculum. This 75-credit hour graduate nursing curriculum prepares registered nurses to deliver primary health care to clients ages birth to adolescence, focusing on patient-and-family centered care within the context of the family unit. Emphasis is placed on health promotion and disease prevention, in addition to management of acute and chronic illnesses. With an additional 14 Acute Care credit hours, the PNP-AC/PC concentration also prepares registered nurses to deliver health care to pediatric clients with complex acute, critical, or chronic illness in the acute care setting. This is a dual-track online program with required oncampus and virtual immersions.

The program of study conforms to educational guidelines from the Texas Board of Nursing, the Essentials of Doctoral Education for Advanced Nursing Practice (AANC, 2021), the National Organization of Nurse Practitioner Faculties (NONPF), and National Taskforce on Quality Nurse Practitioner Education (NTF, 2022). Graduates from the PNP AC/PC program are eligible to sit for the Pediatric Nursing Certification test offered by the Pediatric Nursing Certification Board (PNCB).
