- TSTC flight and tuition costs are factored into the student's total cost of attendance for the purpose of calculating financial need at Baylor. This is done by Baylor's Student Financial Services department at the time the student is registered for their courses. Additional external funding may be necessary.
- Approximately 90% of students attending Baylor qualify for merit or need based scholarships, grants, student loans, and/or part-time student employment, but it is incumbent upon the student to search and apply for them. - Posted TSTC flight course costs are based on the estimated hours to complete each course. Included are costs for tuition & fees by credit hour, plane usage, fuel expenses, flight instruction, ground instruction, FAA Knowledge Test, FAA Examiner Fee, required number of check rides, flight simulator use, plus a 5% buffer to allow for variance. All unused flight account funds are fully reimbursed.
- Costs may vary depending on student's individual progress, type of aircraft used, and additional courses taken at TSTC.
