- UFC flight training costs are factored into the student's total cost of attendance for the purpose of calculating financial need at Baylor. This is done by Student Financial Services at the time the student is registered for their courses. Award packages do not take into consideration the possibility of flight courses and therefore may not cover the costs entirely. Additional external funding may be necessary.
- Approximately 90% of students attending Baylor qualify for merit or need based scholarships, grants, student loans, and/or parttime student employment, but it is incumbent upon the student to search and apply for them. Many aviation related scholarships and grants are listed on our website at <u>www.Baylor.edu/aviation</u>.
- Costs are based on the number of hours estimated to complete each course at UFC and may vary depending on student's individual progress and the type of aircraft used.
- Included in the flight course estimates are plane usage, fuel expenses, additional fuel surcharge, flight instruction, ground instruction, FAA Knowledge Test, and FAA Examiner Fee with the required number of check rides. The use of a flight simulator may take the place of hours in the airplane as allowed per FAA regulations. All unused flight account funds are fully reimbursed.
